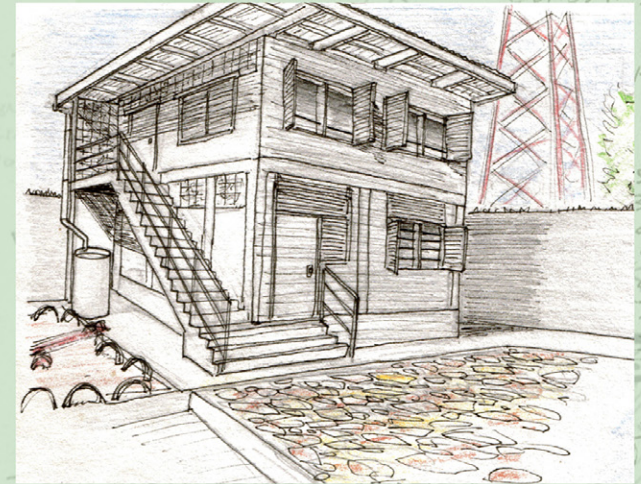


# LANERA LIBRARY

This final project can be considered as a proposal. It is the design of a small library and computer centre for a junior primary school called Kiddy Kare in Abokobi, near Accra. I put together the design while Maarten compiled a material schedule and cost estimation along with the help of a quantity surveyor who had been doing work with us previously. Construction will hopefully commence once sufficient funds have been raised by Jaymie Lanera, the American volunteer who asked for our help.

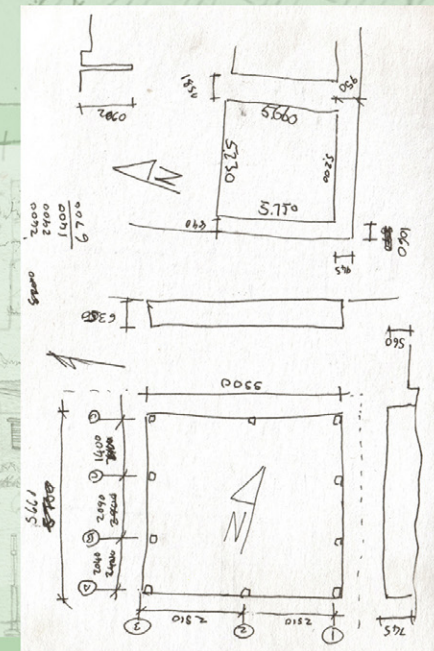
The design had to fit onto a small plinth that had already been built of 630mm high and 5.6m by 5.5m in length and breadth (see below). The Site also had 10 thin columns whose reinforcing was already in place. In the design, 2 of the columns were removed. We considered removing more but decided not to on account of over rather than under-designing, especially considering they were such thin columns.
